Who am I

My name is Aron Calvert, and I am running for Communities Officer in the UL Student Union. I am a socialist and advocate for the equality and fair treatment of all on campus. As Communities Officer, I will be a voice for the marginalised and work to reignite the political spirit of the students and show them change is possible.

What I Stand for

Housing

Housing is a fundamental right for all students, not a privilege. I will:

1. **Campaign for Fair Rents**: I will push for rents to be capped at 30% of the minimum wage, ensuring that housing remains affordable for all students.

- 2. **Tenant Empowerment**: I will work towards establishing tenant unions on campus to combat exploitative landlords and unfair rental practices.
- 3. **Demand Accountability**: I will protest UL's inaction on housing issues and advocate for concrete solutions to ensure safe and affordable housing for all students.

Palestine

We have to fight to end the Genocide in Gaza, I will:

- 1. **BDS Support**: I will actively participate in direct Boycott, Divestment, and Sanctions (BDS) actions to hold Israel accountable for its violations of Palestinian rights.
- 2. **Solidarity Protests**: I will organize regular solidarity protests for Palestine, amplifying the voices of those affected by this genocide.
- 3. End University Complicity: I will pressure UL to sever ties with complicit Israeli universities and uphold principles of justice and human rights.

LGBTQIA+ Rights

We have to fight queerphobia wherever it arises. I will:

- 1. **Social transition fund:** secure funding for a Social Transition Fund which seeks to help trans, non-binary and gender non-conforming students purchase items for social transition which they may not otherwise be able to afford.
- 2. **Stop Deadnaming students**: I will actively campaign to change the system in UL which currently stops students from using their preferred name.
- **3.** Queer voice: I will work tirelessly to make this campus a safer and more welcoming place for the LGBTQIA+ community and ensure their voice is heard.

Anti-Racism

I stand against all forms of racism and discrimination. I will:

- 1. Active Engagement: I will strive to ensure that the student union participates in antiracist actions both on campus and across Ireland, advocating for inclusive and equitable communities.
- 2. **Educational Workshops**: I will organize workshops to educate students in combating the growing threat of the far-right and foster a culture of acceptance and understanding.
- 3. **Boycott Aramark**: Aramark is a company which exploits those in direct provision. These are some of the most vulnerable people on this island and as communities officer I will hold The union's feet to the fire in their boycott of all Aramark locations on campus.

Fees

Education should never be a burden. I will:

- 1. **Fight for Free Education**: I believe we as students are owed free higher education, free for all students, and I will work tirelessly to build a campaign to try make this a reality
- 2. End Repeat Fees: I will push for an end to repeat fees, these fees unfairly burden students and hinder access to education. Enough is enough
- 3. **National Campaign**: I will collaborate with student and activist groups nationwide to pressure UL to join the national campaign to abolish fees and ensure that education is accessible to all.
